Dr. Harry Blackford Succumbs

Dr. Harry Blackford, 74, a retired physician, died Monday in a hospital after a long iliness.

Funeral services will held at noon tomorrow in the Arthur A. Wright & Son chapel. Burial will be in the Hills of Eternity.

Dr. Blackford practiced here about 40 years. He specialized in internal medicine. He was born in Lithuania. He came to this country as a young man and was graduated from the University of Oregon School of Medicine.

Dr. Blackford was in the Medical Corps in the First World War. He was one of the first doctors to establish offices in the Medical and Dental Building. He was a charter member of the Washington Athletic Club but had withdrawn his membership in recent years. He resided at 918 14th Av. N.

Surviving are a sister, Mrs. Jack S. Katz, Scattle, and two nieces, Mrs. William Weinstein, Seattle, and Mrs. Edward Kompel, Los Angeles.
